Formerly the city's High School, the hotel sits in the heart of Stirling, an historic city midway between Edinburgh and Glasgow. Dating back to 1854, when it was the city's High School, the hotel is steeped in Scottish history and boasts a full working



Observatory. Open to hotel guests and local members alike, the Health Club at Barceló Stirling Highland Hotel offers a range of facilities including an indoor swimming pool, sauna, steam room, spa pool, fully equipped gym and squash courts.



The hotel is just minutes from Stirling Castle where Mary Queen of Scots was crowned and eight Scottish sieges took place. You'll also find the Church of the Holy Rude, founded in 1129, and reported to be the only other surviving church in the UK, apart from Westminster Abbey, to have held a coronation, and the Wallace Monument tall above the city.
