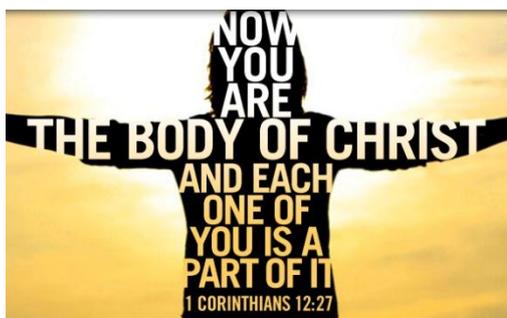
Big Role for 'Mini-Intern'

The next ICF Conference is planned for 2017 in South Africa.

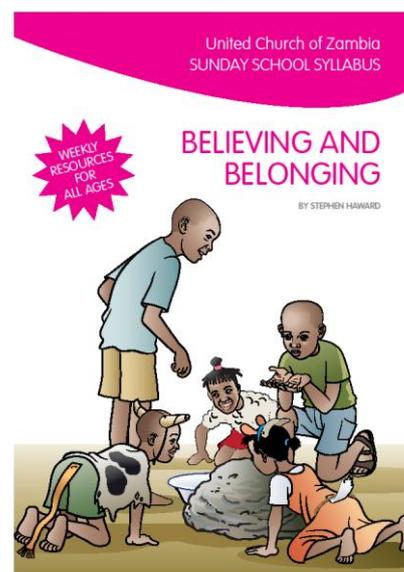
Believing and Belonging in Zambia

Written for the United Church of Zambia, 6,000 copies of Stephen's substantial book are now on board a ship heading to Dar-es-Salaam.

Believing and Belonging uses a wide range of methods to enable children to be creative and playful as they learn in Sunday School. A whole year of Bible lessons is included.

Original storylines and illustrations place the material firmly in an African context, while ordinary household or natural items are used as aids for learning instead of expensive Western materials.

Some copies have been retained in the UK for churches interested in Bible teaching alongside another culture: available from the Office at £10.00.
