Youth for Christ - Gen Z research findings

'In September 2018, a group of 1000 11-18 year olds were given a long list of questions. Thus the research 'Gen Z: The Digital Generation' was born. They were asked about their perspectives and habits using digital media, specifically, their day-to-day use of social media and YouTube and how they affect them as individuals.'

One of their findings was that YouTube was the most likely activity for a young person to engage with in their spare time, and 86% of young people in the survey watch YouTube on their own.
