Course description:

This course is designed to equip you with the necessary tools to create robust safeguarding arrangements. Anyone who works or volunteers directly with adults or in adult focused ministries will benefit such as: counsellors, pastoral workers, adult group leaders and volunteers, prayer ministry teams, street pastors.
