Job Description for ½time Minister.

Role.

Working with the Diaconate the successful candidate will be responsible for leading the Church in promoting the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Job description.

She/He will:-

- Observe the traditions and doctrines of the Congregational church.
- Preach and teach the word of God.
- Encourage the spiritual growth of the members and adherents.
- Encourage church growth by instructing and receiving new people for church membership.
- Conduct 2 Sunday morning services per month.
- Conduct 1 Messy Church service a month (currently Saturdays).
- Administer Holy Communion once a month in church and at home to any sick member who requests this sacrament.
- Conduct infant baptism, wedding and funeral services.
- Build on existing church activities working with and actively seeking new volunteer helpers.
- Be creative in organising and developing new activities to encourage younger people to participate in the life of the church.
- Attend Deacon's and Church meetings. (currently these are held alternate months)
- Dealing with pastoral concerns of members and adherents, some of which may be of a highly confidential nature and may involve liaison with outside agencies.
- Develop ecumenism by involvement in services organised by the local Churches in North Scunthorpe (CINS) group.
- Support Safeguarding practice throughout the church.
